386 PRINCESS GWENLLIAN CENTRE – FUTURE GOVERNANCE

It was noted that 2 organisations have expressed an interest in tendering for the Hall. Tenders have to be returned by 28th February 2022. Tender details will be put onto the website and advertised so that any local interest group may submit a tender.

387 INDUSTRIAL MUSEUM

388 LEASE FOR THE HISTORY SHED EXPERIENCE

The planning application is in the consultation phase. The county council will handle the consultation process. If the application is successful a lease will be drawn up.

389 DEVELOPMENT OF TOWN SQUARE
