### **146 CHRISTMAS ARRANGEMENTS**

It was **RESOLVED** to purchase waterproof reusable banners to attach to barriers at a cost of £500. Some will be used around the tree at Mynydd y Garreg.

The starting point for Santa's parade was queried. A proposal to move the start from the usual Glan yr Afon to the Moat House car park had been made. Implications for road closure were expressed. Volunteer traffic controllers will be required.
